Date	Information
10th October onwards	1 to 1 interviews with Cheryl McCarthy
25th October	You must have submitted your personal statement onto PS16
October and November	Visit post-16 school and college open events (see open events dates flyer)
23rd November	Post-16 Open Event at Manor High
November	Shortlist your school / college choices and your course choices on PS16. You can then amend your application to each individual provider
7th –18th November	Year 11 Pre-Public Exams in school
30th November	This is the deadline for your P16 school / college applications to be made on PS16 We will then check them in school and once
	checked will send them off in early December
February / March 2023	Students will hear from schools / colleges as to whether their application has been successful or not. Interviews with schools and providers are usually scheduled from here onwards too.



Post-16: Key dates for Manor High Yr 11

All students have been working on personal statements with CHS teachers in school. However, the onus is on the students themselves to get these completed and online (staff are more than happy to check them). With this, students have also been gaining information about the different types of course available to them.

Students should visit a range of Post-16 schools and colleges to help them make their decisions regarding where they are going to apply to. Students should always have a back up option and not just apply to one provider.

1 to 1 interviews with Cheryl McCarthy will help students to understand which courses / colleges are best for them. These start in October and continue through November. They happen during school time and are organised for the students.

Post-16 school and college open events take place through October and November.

Our own Manor High Post-16 event on 23rd November is a chance to meet local providers and help students to firm up their decisions before the 30th November deadline.

At all times students can talk to tutors, CHS teachers and staff about any advice and guidance they need.
